



Town Of Wakefield

Property Tax Work-Off Program

Eligibility:

- Age 60 years and over
- Must be the assessed owner of the property on which the tax is exempted
- Property must be primary residence of applicant
- Must have owned residence for at least 5 years
- Must have lived in Massachusetts for at least 10 years
- One per household

All applicants

- Submit application to the Senior Center by posted deadline. Applications will be forwarded to Assessor's Office to determine eligibility
- Must interview to arrange for placement
- Commit to 62.5 hours of service, as assigned, within the specified time frame
- Notify coordinator and work site supervisor of schedule changes and absences
- Turn hours in monthly to the Senior Center
- Notify coordinator of any changes which affect eligibility, i.e. sale of property.

Applicant will receive:

- An exemption of \$500.00 on their real estate tax bill in exchange for 62.5 hours of community service

Placements:

- Determined by matching applicant's skills, interests and availability with job requests submitted

Time Frame:

- **Effective July 1, 2012 – June 30, 2013**
- Applications must be submitted to the Senior Center, 30 Converse Street Wakefield MA 01880, by **June 1, 2012.**
